Welcome to the new school year at the AIA Weekend Islamic School. We are committed to provide quality Islamic education and excellent services to your children. We are excited to build on our successes from the past by implementing what worked best for us and learning lessons from our mistakes. We have a very competent group of dedicated teachers who are willing to offer their services despite constraints of their social and family obligations.

Please note that children 5 years old and above on September 1, 2019 will be enrolled in school.

Please fill out the Enrollment form and return to AIA by **August 18, 2019**. It can be mailed in or dropped off in the AIA School black drop-box outside the Main Office door. *Please note that enrollment after that date will require a late fee of \$100 per family, and only if space is available.*

We expect the parents and students to take AIA School as seriously as regular school. We implement strict rules in the School to keep discipline and achieve high standard of education.

School will start on Sunday, September 08, 2019. Regular school hours are 11am to 1:50pm.

- **OPTIONAL 10:30am to 11am:** Early Hour Class for Quran Reading/Tajweed for those needing extra help
- **11am to 12 noon:** Period 1
- **12:00 to 12:30pm:** School-provided lunch and recess play-time.
- **12:30pm to 1:30pm:** Period 2.
- **1:30pm to 1:40pm:** Short break for students to perform wudu' and head to Prayer Hall
- **1:40pm to 1:50pm:** Dhuhr Prayers [the prayer is part of the regular school day].
- **1:50pm: PICK-UP TIME.**

After the completion of Prayers, students are to be picked up promptly no later than 2pm. The parents **MUST** park their cars and come inside to pick up their children. These rules are for student safety. AIA School must implement these rules in order to comply with the safety requirements for anyone at AIA and its students & staff, as dictated by the Frankfort Police Department and Security agency.

All students receive age-appropriate instruction in each of their classes. For each class (grade level), students get one hour of Quran Class and one hour of Islamic Studies. Please see School Handbook for syllabus/curriculum details. In addition to the regular school classes, AIA School also offers an Early Hour class from 10:30am to 11:00am for students who need to catch up to their fellow students in their class for reading Arabic (Quran) from whatever skill level they are at when they start.

We expect to start each class on time. It is the parents' responsibility to bring their child to the School on time. Attendance is absolutely necessary for children to keep a sense of commitment to the Islamic School. Regular attendance helps in continuity and keeps the children focused on topics under discussion.

Textbooks will be supplied to the students on the first day of school.

We look forward to welcoming our new and returning students to our school, where the school motto is: "Excellence in Education, Worship and Character!"
